

MISSION

The Blood Center Foundation of the Inland Northwest raises funds and invests in education, technology and research grants in support of your regional healthcare community and Inland Northwest Blood Center.

INVESTING FUNDS

The Blood Center Foundation of the Inland Northwest invested \$110,904 in grants in 2016. A sample of our support:

Education

- \$13,500 to renew the Phlebotomy Student Scholarships for the 2016-2017 academic year at the Community Colleges of Spokane, North Idaho College and Lewis-Clark State College.

Technology

- \$10,996 to Providence Health Care Foundation Eastern Washington for an RX Monza Chemical Analyzer for the Providence Sacred Heart Medical Center School of Medical Laboratory Science.

Research

- \$31,000 to Blood Systems Inc. for collaborative research at the Inland Northwest Blood Center to perform research to present to the Food and Drug Administration to make platelets safer and expand their shelf life from five to seven days.

Jean Merrill Education Fund

In honor of the retirement of longtime INBC leader Jean Merrill, an education fund was established in 2006. Jean endowed this fund to provide educational training for INBC staff and Spokane area health professionals. Financial gifts to the Jean Merrill Education Fund are raised annually through Bricks for Life donations, Valentine Cookie Sale and general contributions.
